RBI Grade B Application Fee

Payment of the application fee for the RBI Grade B exam is the final and most important step of the process. The payment is meant to be done through online mode. Candidates can check the category-wise application fee amount as per the last year's notification.

RBI Grade B Eligibility

The first step after an exam notification gets released is the online application. It is advised that before candidates start applying for the RBI

Grade B exam, they should be in check for the eligibility requirements that are mandatory for a successful application. There are certain parameters under which the **RBI Grade B Eligibility** is determined such as educational qualification, age limit, nationality, etc. Therefore, as soon as the notification is released, candidates should first check for all these eligibility requirements.

RBI Grade B Age Limit

The aspirants willing to apply for the RBI Grade B recruitment 2023 should know that they need to fall under the age bracket of minimum and maximum age limit.

- A candidate should at least be 21 years of age while applying for the RBI Grade
 B Officer post.
- The maximum age limit is 30 years.
- There is an exception for the candidates possessing Ph.D. & M.Phil degrees according to which the maximum age limits are 34 years & 32 years respectively.

RBI Grade B Educational Qualification

Candidates must know that they need to possess specific educational qualification/s in order to be **eligible for the RBI Grade B exam**. The qualification may vary as per the post.

RBI Grade B Eligibility Criteria	
Post	Qualification
RBI Grade B Officer (General)	A minimum of 60% marks in the Bachelor's degree or PG degree with equivalent technical qualification with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate.

RBI Grade B Officer (Department of Economic and Policy Research)	A Master's Degree in Economics or Finance, with a minimum of 55% marks from a recognized Indian or Foreign University
RBI Grade B (Department of Statistics and Information Management)	A Master's Degree in Statistics or Mathematical Statistics/ Mathematical with a minimum of 55% marks

RBI Grade B Selection Process

Aspirants need to go through the detailed notification of RBI Grade B to ensure that they do not miss out on any important information such as the selection process. The selection process of RBI Grade B is a three-tiered process as follows:

- Phase 1 (Prelims) Written Examination
- Phase 2 (Mains) Written Examination
- Phase 3 Interview

RBI Grade B Syllabus

To ace the examination, it is extremely important for the candidates to have thorough information on the RBI Grade B syllabus. It is important for a better understanding of the exam. It also assists in enabling the candidates to prepare a proper study schedule that includes all the important subjects and topics.

The **RBI Grade B syllabus is divided into two main parts of Phase 1 & Phase 2 syllabus**. Both exams are in a written format having various subjects such as Quantitative Aptitude, Reasoning Ability, and English Language.

RBI Grade B Exam Pattern

One of the most important aspects of exam preparation is having complete and genuine information which is relevant to the exam. RBI Grade B exam pattern is one such significant piece of information that every candidate needs to know before starting the exam preparation. The paper pattern is simply divided into two main parts of Phase 1 & Phase 2.

Candidates should have complete information on the RBI Grade B exam pattern which involves the various sections/subjects asked, the marking

scheme, allotted time duration, and the number of questions. There is a slight difference in the RBI Grade B exam pattern for Phase 1 & Phase 2.

RBI Grade B Exam Pattern Phase 1 (Prelims)

RBI Grade B Phase I exam consists of four sections: **General Awareness**, **English Language**, **Quantitative Aptitude & Reasoning Ability**. The exam will be in an objective manner and all the sections will carry 200 marks.

RBI Grade B Exam Pattern Phase 2 (Mains)

The RBI Grade B exam pattern for Mains consists of three sections, two of which are objective type tests and one is descriptive type. The Mains exam pattern recently saw a change in the last year's notification where the weightage of the descriptive test was increased.

- Paper 1 & Paper 3 of RBI Grade B Mains are partially objective and partially descriptive.
- The objective part of both papers is allotted 30 minutes whereas the descriptive part is allotted 90 minutes.

RBI Grade B Interview

All the eligible candidates that clear Phase 2 of the RBI Grade B exam are called for an interview. These candidates are shortlisted based on their Phase 2 marks. The call letters for the interviews are emailed to the candidates 15 days before the interview date.

- The RBI Grade B interview carries a total weightage of 75 marks.
- It is the candidates' choice to opt for English or Hindi as the medium of interview.
